

The World Scout Youth Forum (WSYF) provides an opportunity for young members of World Scouting to **discuss and express their views on different issues on scouting as well as our society in general**. Through preparing inputs and making recommendations to the World Conference and to the World Scout Committee, to which the Forum is linked, participants will develop the skills necessary to strengthen their capacity to take part in decision-making processes. Furthermore, it is a **perfect place to meet people that are dedicated to Scouting** and that are trying to leave this world a little better than they found it.

### Preparation phase

The WSYF participant is **part of the Swiss delegation to the World Scout Conference 2014 (WSC)** in Ljubljana (Slovenia). This means that he will take part in the whole preparation phase as well as a regular delegate in the WSC from 11<sup>th</sup> to 15<sup>th</sup> August 2014 following the WSYF.

### The candidate

We are looking for a young motivated scout under 26 that is committed to the international dimension of scouting. Previous international scouting experiences are an asset, but not a precondition.

You are willing and able to work with international scouting issues within the Swiss Guide and Scout Movement (MSdS / PBS) even after the WSYF.

You have a good command of English and you speak either French or German (or both). Further language skills are an asset, as are previous experiences with political and multilateral processes.
